The IECEU Project

The IECEU-project researches new approaches and solutions to long-term peacebuilding in EU external actions, aiming at improving the effectiveness of the EU's capabilities for conflict prevention and create more enduring impact on the ground.

The Event

During the EAPTC 2017, the IECEU-project will organise a policy dialogue to present its findings relating to 15 CSDP crisis management operations. These will be discussed with representatives of training institutes, government, NGO's and academia, with a view to identify recommendations.

The Consortium

The IECEU consortium is coordinated by Laurea University of Applied Sciences (Finland) and consists of a diverse group of research, governmental and private sector organisations from Austria (AIES), Denmark (Royal Defence College), Finland (CMC, FINCENT and Safer Globe), Slovenia (CEP and University of Ljubljana), Ireland (University of Maynooth) and the Netherlands (Enquiryra).



The Programme

The IECEU-policy dialogue will take place on 2 May 2017, from 16:30 until 19:00 at the venue of the EAPTC 2017, the Hotel Scandic Paasi. It will consist of two sessions:

Session 1: 15:00 - 16:15

This session will focus on CSDP crisis management operations and the training organisation and staff competences.

Session 2: 16:30 - 17:30

This session will focus on CSDP crisis management operations and the comprehensive approach.

In both sessions, the research findings will be shared and discussed, in order to define major policy recommendations.
